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Day One – Welcome to New England & Coastal Maine

Arrive at Boston Logan International Airport, where your tour director and local guide will greet you. Once aboard your motorcoach, depart for the stunning coastline of Maine and the picturesque town of Ogunquit, whose name, given by the Abenaki Indians, means “beautiful place by the sea.” Check into The Meadowmere Resort, freshen up, and prepare for a warm welcome dinner to begin your journey.

Meals: Dinner

Day Two – Ogunquit, York & Boothbay Harbor Cruise

After breakfast, continue north to the Mid-Coast region and the delightful seaside village of Boothbay Harbor. Enjoy lunch on your own and some free time to browse local shops and galleries. Embark on a scenic cruise out of Boothbay Harbor, where you'll witness wildlife such as puffins, seals, seabirds, historic lighthouses, and summer colonies. Afterward, continue to Rockland and check into the Rockland Harbor Hotel. Take time to freshen up and enjoy the evening at your leisure to dine at one of several restaurants along Main Street. **Meals: Breakfast**

Day Three – Rockland, Rockport, Camden, Mount Battie, Fort Knox State Park & Mount Desert Island

Start your day with breakfast before touring the picturesque Mid-Coast region, including the charming towns of Thomaston, Rockport, and Camden. Enjoy visiting the popular Maine Prison Store to browse the many eclectic handmade items. Enjoy a drive up Mount Battie for sweeping views of Camden Harbor and the surrounding coastline. Then, enjoy free time in Camden to explore the shops and have lunch on your own. This afternoon, visit The Fort Knox State historic site, one of America's best-preserved examples of seacoast fortifications constructed in the 1800s and enjoy breathtaking views of the Penobscot Bay area. Then, journey to Mount Desert Island and check into the Bar Harbor Regency Hotel overlooking Frenchman's Bay for a relaxing two-night stay and a delightful dinner. **Meals: Breakfast, Dinner**

Day Four – Acadia National Park & Free Afternoon in Bar Harbor

This morning, tour the breathtaking Acadia National Park, with stops at Thunder Hole and Cadillac Mountain, where you'll enjoy panoramic views of Frenchman's Bay and the Porcupine Islands. Spend the late morning exploring the charming village of Bar Harbor, with free time for lunch on your own. Enjoy the balance of the day and evening at leisure in the afternoon to shop and dine in Bar Harbor's inviting restaurants.

Meals: Breakfast

Day Five – Portland, Kennebunkport & Ogunquit

After breakfast, depart for Portland to explore the historic Old Port Exchange, a vibrant area once the heart of Portland's 19th-century commercial life. Visit Portland Head Light, commissioned by George Washington and one of the nation's oldest continuously operating lighthouses. Continue south to Kennebunkport, where a scenic drive along the ocean leads to Walker's Point and the summer residence of former President George H.W. Bush. Enjoy free time in Dock Square before continuing to Ogunquit to check into the Anchorage by the Sea. End the day with a traditional lobster dinner. **Meals: Breakfast, Lobster Dinner**

Day Six – Nubble Lighthouse & Flight Home

After breakfast, stop for a photo opportunity at the iconic Cape Neddick Lighthouse, affectionately known as "The Nubble," one of the world's most photographed lighthouses. Later, return to Boston Logan International Airport for your journey home, bringing cherished memories of Coastal Maine's stunning landscapes and rich maritime history. **Meals: Breakfast**
